Announcements

Due to low registrations the Sheree Bingheim weave scheduled for May 15th has been cancelled. We will re-schedule Sheree for another time.

An email was sent out to gauge interest for the remaining BAG events. If you have not sent your response to Deb yet, please do! The cost to have events at the Long Creek Community Center is \$150/day or \$200/weekend. The guild has been also paying for the hotel room for the teacher for a maximum of 2 nights. When we do meet we plan on offsetting costs with 50/50's and the sale of some donated items.



Due to the on going pandemic, we moved our annual Christmas Weave to Saturday, July 10th. We hope you will be able to join us.



Saturday, June 26th @ the Long Creek Community Center, 9am - 5pm Come weave with Carol Osborn and Leesa Tipton!

First up on Saturday, June 26th is Carol Osborn. Carol will be leading the weave with wire. If you have not woven with wire before, this is a great opportunity! Tools needed are: wire cutters, (2) bobbins, and an awl. Color choices are: white with orange specks, white with navy specks, white with green specks. You can change the shape of the basket just by adjusting the size of the base. Cost is \$5 and the deadline to sign up is June 14th. The size will vary a bit depending on weave but they are approximately 2" H and 2 1/2" across the top to give you an idea. The blue basket on the right is 4" diameter and 1 1/4" H.







Next up Leesa Tipton will be leading us in the afternoon weaving with naturals. Exploring naturals create a small basket using green leaves from Tiger &/or Day lily leaves. There will be a discussion of other local natural weaving materials.

You will need sandpaper, small towel, scissors, awl, crimping tool, and bucket. If possible, bring some Tiger or Daylily leaves. Cut and rinse 1 or 2 days before class and keep in a cool place.

The minimum number to hold this class is 6 and the maximum number of students is 12. The cost is \$40. We will be weaving with Leesa from 1pm to 5pm. The basket is approximately $4\text{"W} \times 6\text{"L} \times 4\text{"H}$. The deadline to register is June 14th.





The plastic bobbins look like the above picture. They are great for weaving with long pieces of round reed too! These can be found at Hobby Lobby in the same aisle as leather and macrame. They are inexpensive to buy. You will need two.

Carol's Class is 9am - noon Leesa's Class is 1pm - 5pm

We will be having potluck for lunch and snacks. Please bring something to share.

We are planning on a 50/50 and the sale of basket items by donations to help offset the cost of renting the facility.

As always there will be door prizes. Feel free to bring something! If not, no worries we have items ready!
