We also host workshops that are taught by accomplished basket artisans.



We appreciate your cooperation with this request.







Iced Maple Pecan Cookies - Julie Williams

(1) Betty Crocker Butter Pecan Cake Mix 1/3 C Butter, softened

- 2 large eggs
- 2 tsp. maple extract
- 1 cup chopped pecans
- 1 recipe maple icing (follows)



Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray cookie sheets with non-stick spray. Position oven rack to middle of the oven.

In a large mixing bowl, place half of the cake mix along with the softened butter, eggs and maple extract. Blend with electric mixer set on medium-high speed, 1-2 minutes until blended and smooth. Stir in the remaining cake mix and pecans with a wooden spoon until all dry ingredients are moistened.

Drop dough by teaspoonfuls, 2 inches apart, onto prepared cookie sheets. Bake 9-12 minutes or until set at edges and just barely set at center when lightly touched. Cool 1 minute on sheets. Transfer to wire racks and cool completely.

Prepare maple icing:

1 1/2 cups powdered sugar 3 oz cream cheese, softened 1Tbsp. Butter, softened 1 1/2 tsp maple extract

Beat above in small mixing bowl and frost cooled cookies.
