Breakfast Sliders - Julie Cundiff

Ingredients

1 dozen eggs 1/2 C. milk Salt & Pepper to taste 12-18 Hawaiian Buns (sliced) 1/2 lb. sliced ham Sliced American Cheese

Topping

1 stick butter 1/2 Tbsp. Dijon Mustard 1/2 Tbsp. Worcestershire 1/2 Tbsp. poppy seeds



Beat eggs & milk. Pour in pan @ 350 degrees for 20 minutes or until the eggs are done. In another pan, layer bun bottoms, ham, and cheese. Flip eggs onto the buns. Place the top buns on the eggs. Melt butter, add salt & pepper and spoon onto the buns. Bake at 350 degrees for 20 to 30 minutes.


