All workshops are held at the Long Creek Community Center unless otherwise stated.


We also host workshops that are taught by accomplished basket artisans.





5. Pass all records and papers in good order to the incoming secretary no later than ten days after the end of term

## Nominating Committee


The BAG Board is currently looking for members to serve on a nominating committee.







## Monday, June 6, 2022



LLBWA is excited to welcome Becky Bechtel as their teacher for the 2022 Starved Rock Weave. She has designed a beautiful round basket called "STASIA" for the event. Student choices for the acrylic poured and epoxy resin sealed slotted wood bases includes : Teal/Blue or Brown/Bronze/Gold/Black.

Becky has patterns and kits available on her website: [www.BrightExpectationsBaskets.com](http://www.BrightExpectationsBaskets.com). She also publishes a newsletter; "The Reed Reader" for weaving enthusiasts, as well as organizes the annual "Weaving in the Sunshine State" basket weaving retreat held annually in Fort Myers, Florida.

Techniques used to weave "Stasia" include: chase twining, continuous twill weaving, triple twining/three rod wale and braid weave (border/rim). The deadline to order kits is **May 15, 2022**.

Please register as early as possible because it takes a month to complete the process on the bases. LLBWA will need to let Becky know numbers ASAP. 
