Our RV serves as our home, workplace, and the birthplace of numerous basket designs. My mobile studio is fully equipped to craft any type of reed basket.

I currently teach at many basket conventions throughout the US. In addition to convention teaching, I also enjoy offering classes with various basket guilds.

If your guild is looking for a guest teacher, I would love to come teach. I can also provide your guild with basket kits for group weaving sessions. I am willing to work out discounted pricing on these kits.

For the last 29 years, I've devoted my life to teaching and spreading the art of basket weaving, a passion that has led me through 27 states, Germany, and the Caribbean, highlighted by the Basket Weaving Cruise.

Confetti - \$80 / 6 hr. This class will start at 9am.

Level: Beginner Intermediate

Dimensions: 15" x 7" x 6" H

This vibrant basket features a racetrack wooden base and dyed reed spokes. It is crafted using fundamental weaving techniques such as over-under with dyed flat oval reed, along with triple twining and tie-twining.

Wooden dowel cap feet are added to enhance the basket's charming appearance.



Lola's Designer Tote - \$85 / 8hr. This class will start at 9:30am.

Level: All Levels

Dimensions: 12" x 7" x 8" H

Available in three vibrant color schemes, Teal Multi, Ginger Multi, or Navy Multi. This tote basket has a wood base, 5 different colors of dyed reed, cozy variegated yarn and matching leather handles. The tote's height is adjustable—add more rows of weaving for a taller tote that can hold numerous items, or fewer for a compact version ideal as a purse. All the reed to make a taller version is included in the kit.

This sturdy tote starts with inserting natural and 5 different colors of dyed reed spokes into a racetrack wood base. Techniques include triple twine with a step up, basic over under weave, double triple twine, 4 Rod Wale using yarn, and a traditional lashed rim with leather handles.

Dimensions: 11" x 3" x 6.5" H



This product needs to be ordered with the kit to insure stock.

This functional insert is an instant upgrade for your tote basket. The multiple pockets allow you to organize your daily essentials. The beige insert is made of lightweight, durable felt fabric. The exterior has 2 insert pockets on one side and 1 large insert pocket on the opposite side. The interior has 9 insert pockets and a detachable zipper compartment in the middle. It has a removable claw hook strap to connect the insert to your basket if desired.

Kitchen Collection Oval - \$50 / 4 hr. This class will start at 9am.

Level: Beginner

Dimensions: 12" x 9" x 3.5" H

This functional basket is woven on a beautifully stained black wood base with natural reed spokes. It is designed to hold an oval casserole dish (NOT INCLUDED). Techniques include: Setting up spokes on an oval slotted wood base, over under start stop weaving, adding braided leather handles to the side weavers and a traditional lashed rim.



Lazy Susan - \$53 / 4 hr.

This class will start at 9am.

Level: All Levels

Dimensions: 11" Dia x 4.5" H

Beginning with a 10-inch round Lazy Susan base, students will master the fundamental over-under start-stop weave, complemented by a rickrack overlay design, and finished with a simple lashed rim. A variety of dyed reed colors will be available to choose from.

Dimensions: 6" x 4.5 x 3.5" H
