Copper Façade

Time: 4 Hours (starts at 10am)

Price: \$58

Dimensions: 7.5"(l) x 5.5"(w) x 6.5"
(height with handle)

Weaving Level: All Weaving Levels

Tools required: Standard basketry tools



This basket has a woven bottom and a simple over/under weave pattern. What makes this weave different is the entire sides are over-layed with copper strips. The rim is lashed with waxed linen. Students will learn a shortcut to keep the base from shifting while upsetting the spokes without a locking row. The color is a beautiful dark espresso.



Hanging Hope

Time: 8 Hours (starts at 9am)

Price: \$90

Dimensions: Diameter 14" x 17"(height with hook)

Weaving Level: Intermediate Weaving Level

Tools required: Standard basketry tools and a knife to shape the spokes.



This is a "non-typical rib basket. It starts with (2)14" round hoops as the frame. Techniques include weaving a large God's Eye and inserting a first and second set of ribs. Students will also twine, continuous weave with step-up, 3 rod wale weave and start/stop weave. It is finished with a hook on top. This is a very strong basket. It is woven in natural color. Staining will be discussed. Not a good class for newer weavers.

Farmhouse Blessing Basket

Time: 4 Hours (starts at 10am)

Price: \$55

Dimensions: 14" (L) x 5.25" (W) x 5.25"
(height with handle)

Weaving Level: All Weaving Levels

Tools required: Standard basketry tools



This cute basket has a woven bottom and a basic over/under weave pattern on the sides. It is woven in natural color with dark brown rim and handle. Waxed linen is used to lash the rim. This is a good class for a newer weaver as well as an experienced one.



Boot Scootin'

Time: 6 Hours (starts at 9am)

Price: \$105

Dimensions: 15"(L) x 8"(W) x 10.5" (height without handle)

Weaving Level: All Weaving Levels

Tools required: Standard basketry tools

This classy basket starts with a stained, oak base. Students will learn twining, 3 rod wale, start/stop over/under weaving and over-laying. The color combination will be brown-mustard and natural with espresso-brown accents. It is finished with a black leather handle and a bronze bolo tie. Students will lash the rim with waxed linen.
