This is a great opportunity to get some weaving done before the crazy holiday season!

We will break each day for thirty minutes for lunch. Feel free to bring a sack lunch or there are many restaurant options nearby. The guild will provide snacks, napkins, cutlery, plates and cups. There is a fridge, microwave and stove at the facility for us to use.

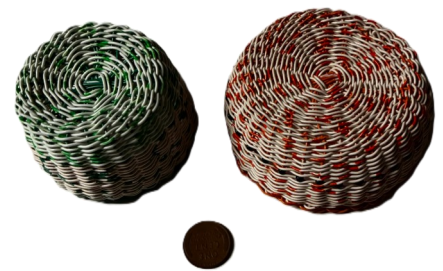

Project: Mini Wire Basket
Hours: 3-4
Cost: \$5
Weaving Level: All levels
Dimensions: Approximately 2.25" x 1.75"
(3.25" in diameter x 1.25" high)

Carol will lead us in weaving with telephone wire. If you haven't tried a mini basket before, now is a great opportunity! This basket is twined with a simple border. This cute little trinket basket is a lot of fun to weave.

Due to availability of materials, class size is limited to 8 students.

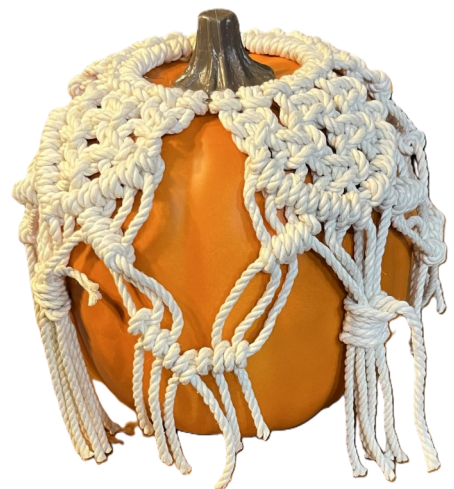
The baskets in the bottom picture are shown with a penny. If you have bobbins to use for the wire, please bring them!

Project: Macrame Pumpkin Topper
Hours: 2-3 hours
Cost: \$20
Weaving Level: All levels
Dimensions: The top of the pumpkin is 7" and the bottom is 8"



The Macrame Pumpkin topper starts with Larkshead knots on a 4-inch steel ring, followed by square knots, followed by double half hitch knots with some gathering knots to finish. We will be using 4.5mm cord and working over a foam pumpkin for a mold, which is included in the class price.

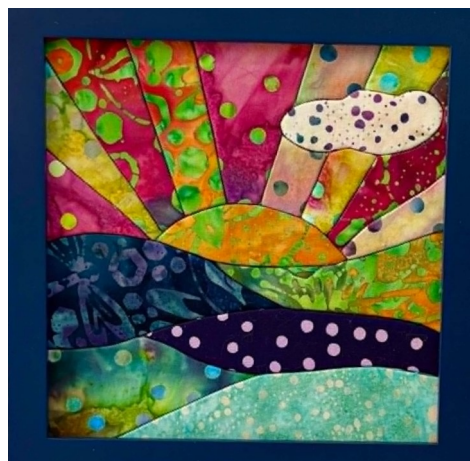

Project: Kinusaiga
Hours: 3
Cost: \$40
Weaving Level: All levels
Dimensions: 8" x 10"

Join me for a beginner-friendly class learning the Japanese art of Kinusaiga. We'll be creating one unique design with scraps of fabric, without a single stitch! You get to choose your fabrics and place them wherever you want within your own piece. Your finished 8x10 artwork can be displayed as is or framed like the class sample.

Note: the frame is not included in the class price. This is a wonderfully creative and relaxing art form that takes patience and precision. We will be using a sharp craft knife, so for safety, this will be an adults only class.

Pam will bring a variety of fabrics to choose from.
Please choose either the landscape picture or basket picture on the registration form.



Saturday afternoon's basket classes are on page 5. Not really wanting to take a class but want to come for the fellowship? Not a problem! You can "open weave". Either bring something from your stash or Bonnie will have kits for sale. Do you want to work on a different craft project? Not a problem! Bring it with you. Registration is \$10/day.

Project: Cozy Season Wall/Door Basket

Hours: 3-4

Cost: \$50

Weaving Level: All levels

Dimensions: 8" L x 13" H x 2" W



"Cozy Season" starts on a "Quick Weave" handle. If you have never used this type of handle before, you are in for a treat. You just slide the spokes in and weave! The accent colors are a rich Mulberry, Moss Green, and Golden Brown. This basket is a wall or door basket. Two embellishments are included to get you from Autumn through Winter.

Project: Fall Frolic

Hours: 4

Cost: \$45

Weaving Level: All levels

Dimensions: 12" L x 6" H (10" H including handle) x 6 1/2" W

"Fall Frolic" starts by weaving a woven, filled base using a 6" x 10" D handle. Techniques include setting up a woven, filled base, twining, start/stop weaving, four-rod wale with a step up, the use of overlays and double lashing.

The accent colors are black, mustard, and smoked. A button embellishment with pip berries adorns the front.



Don't have basket tools yet? No worries! Bonnie will be bringing her tool boxes to use during class.
