In addition to the stoneware and basketry supplies, gift items are offered such as plates that are seasonal in folk art design. All stoneware and gift items are made here with emphasis on detail to ensure customer satisfaction.

My business is comprised of designing baskets, making stoneware discs and teaching basket classes. I have taught at conventions and retreats all over the Midwest since the mid '90s. My most popular kits are those with a 2-3 hour time frame.

Navy blue, red and natural spokes/weavers create the pattern for this Patriotic Market Basket. The oak handle is inserted into the basket. Attention will be given to shaping and weaving tension.



Braided Hearth Basket
