Meet Dani Sue Anderson...

BASKET ART GUILD





Danielle (Herndon) Anderson is the owner and Chief Weaving Officer at Dani Sue Creations. Danielle, also known as Dani or Dani Sue, started her basket weaving business in 2016 in Louisville, Kentucky.

Growing up in Taylorsville, KY, a small town outside of Louisville, Danielle spent most of her days at her Granny (Ardia Herndon) and Pepaw's house. Granny began weaving in 1982, the same year Danielle was born, and taught classes for over 30 years. When Danielle was 6 years old her Granny taught her how to make her first basket—a Nantucket! When Danielle asked Granny why she started her on such a hard basket Granny quickly replied, "Well, I thought if you could make the hard baskets, you could really make the easy ones!" Danielle's love of weaving and passion to expand the art to a new generation of weavers led her to launch Dani Sue Creations in 2016. Granny continued to help Danielle with her basket business until she passed on May 10, 2019.

Continuing her Granny's legacy as a basket teacher, Danielle has taught at the Kentucky Basket Association State Convention and the Kentucky Guild. She has also expanded into art education, including working with professors at the University of Texas Art Department, serving as a featured presenter at the Austin Fiber Artists, as well as spending time educating local elementary and high school classes and art teachers across the state. Her work was featured nationally in Art Education.

Danielle and her husband, Christopher, are parents to 3 amazing girls – Lillie Grace, Hannah Kay and Ella Rae. As you can imagine, there is never a dull moment as a stay-at-home mom of 3, small business owner and living on the family farm with their goldendoodle, Bear.

Having moved her family and business from Louisville, KY, to Austin, TX, and most recently back to the family farm in Taylorsville, KY, Dani continues to pioneer innovative ways to connect with and serve weavers of all ages and skill levels. From original basket designs, to in-person and virtual classes, to kits, supplies, apparel and more, Dani Sue Creations loves finding ways to weave memories and resource you to learn, connect and share the joys of basket weaving.

Danielle's passion and joy for people and basket weaving is contagious. One of the most exciting innovations that has come from that passion has been the creation of her annual subscription membership group, The Flock. Beginning in 2018, this group connects weavers from across the U.S. through in- person and online experiences, in which members receive first rights on six original Dani Sue basket designs, all materials, and instructional support.

Game On Basket, \$65

Dimensions: 34" Circumference by 6 1/2" Tall

Get ready to play with the Game On Basket! This colorful basket includes a checkerboard lid and checker pieces, making it perfect for fun and games anytime. Use it to store game pieces, cards, or anything



Lillie's Basket, \$35

Dimensions: 6" x 7" x 4" (not including handles)

A new Dani Sue Creation original design, inspired by my oldest daughter who loves pink and purple! This basket comes with a wooden panel/letter. There will be a variety of embellishments to choose from at class time.



Labyrinth, \$95

Finished Basket Dimensions:

3." tall, 21.75" x 21.75" base, 84" circumference.

This stunning basket is extra special because of the story behind it. According to Google, "labyrinths are used world-wide to quiet the mind, calm anxieties, recover balance in life, enhance creativity and encourage meditation, insight, self-reflection, and stress reduction."

This basket is born out of that spirit and features an incredible weaving technique and pattern, which came from fellow basket maker, teacher, friend and mentor Anne Bowers. Her inspiration and collaboration make this basket extra special. Featuring a stunning pattern, this large basket is ready to inspire!



Poppins, \$55

Dimensions: 5" tall, 8" diameter at the top, 30" circumference around the middle of the basket.



Dani Sue Created this Basket during the heat of the Pandemic. Here's what she had to say... It's easy to understand why I would have Poppins on my mind while designing a basket. However, what I've learned with all this Poppins-watching has been very good for me during this hard and

stretching pandemic season. First, it means I get cuddles with my girls while watching; but the

movie brings a lot of chaos into order, just like in the original Mary Poppins movie. She snaps her fingers, and toys go into place and beds get

made. In Mary Poppins Returns, they all end up swimming into the bathtub and have a lovely time while Poppins sings...

In both movies, the families had fallen on hard times - can you relate? I think it's very safe to say we have collectively fallen on hard and unusual times, as everything drastically changed for each of us. But just like Poppins comes in and brings class and charm to any room she's in, I think this basket does the same. I designed it to have character and to be a bit whimsical. If you remember, the families live on Cherry Blossom Lane; hence the color I used for this original basket.



For The Art of It, \$85

Diameter A 16.5", diameter B 14", 51" circumference around the middle of the basket, 12" tall (wood base)

This basket is meant to be a celebration and collaboration of artists. My dear friend Christina Bain introduced me to my dear friend Jenny Evans. Both are art professors and I feel smarter, braver, and more empowered as an artist just by being in their presence. They aren't just fellow artists, but fellow basket weavers and art dreamers. Jenny had the idea of macramé on a bas-

ket. My first thought was "that sounds amazing." The second was "how does one macramé?"

Lucky for me, one day Jenny came to The Nest and taught Lillie, my 8-year-old, and me, how to macramé. From that little 5-minute lesson, and a YouTube video, came the idea of this basket. I sketched it out with Jenny, and weeks later, got to make that crazy doodle into this 3D creation. I believe we are all much better off when surrounded by other people who are good for us, who want more for us and want to help us in this journey called life. That's what my basket friends are!

I couldn't be more thankful for them and the different perspectives and arts they teach and tell me about. When I think of life without my fellow artists and weavers, I think of how much beauty and the ideas I'd be missing out on. I'm thankful for collaboration and the friends that make me a better artist. I can say that this is my favorite all time basket... for now. I'm shocked by how much I love its simplicity and complexity, beauty, and size. In my mind, I picture it in a guest bathroom with pretty towels rolled up and stored; but just like any basket, it can do a lot of different jobs. I hope you enjoy this piece of art as much as I already have.



4-H Basket, \$40

Base: 5" x 5" - Height: 11.5" (with handle) - Diameter: 10"



A great 4-H Basket Project is the Williamsburg Basket, made with a medium-sized Williamsburg D Handle; it's accented with 3 rows of green (the official 4-H color).

Farmer's Market Tote, \$85

Dimensions: 13" L x 5" W x 13" H



You'll enjoy creating this generously-sized easy-to-make basket with natural reed, dyed reed, and paper splint. The set of leather handles add a great look, and they are so practical! The filled base makes this basket perfect for shopping or carrying projects.

Basic techniques include stop/start rows of weaving along with standard tucking, rims and lashing.
